Elecheck (EST) Limited, its management and employees aims to minimise the impact of its operations on the environment, in order to reduce the rate of depletion of the world's natural resources and the pollution of air, water and land.

The company undertakes to comply with all the current and future prescribed legislative and statutory provisions for environmental standards.


It is the aim of the company to increase the level of environmental awareness in the following ways:-

The Managing Director has the overall and final responsibility for the Environmental Policy with the HR Manager in charge of the co-ordination, implementation and monitoring of the policy throughout the organisation.

The Environmental Policy update will be communicated to all staff and a copy will be issued to in their Staff Handbook. Each staff member takes responsibility for their own work area. Copies may be made available to customers on request.

The policy will be reviewed annually at Board Meetings and any updates cascaded throughout the company.
